It does so from a pragmatic approach, i.e., language situations, purposes of communication, topics and genres, with an aim to develop students communication skills. It covers German pronunciation correction, daily conversations, basic vocabulary, cultural issues in German-speaking countries, listening comprehension and conversations of different topics. equip students with standard German pronunciation, basic vocabulary, general grammatical rules and skills in listening comprehension, spoken German, and communication. This is done through comprehensive training in German listening and speaking as well as real-life application. Simple articles of a variety of topics and background are also taught in class to improve students understanding of German. With its focus on listening and speaking, this course also aims to improve students skills in the use of German, cross-culture communication, analyzing and commenting, and thinking from a German perspective, so as to help students lay a solid foundation for further study in their junior and senior years.
